¹ Then Job replied: ² "Even today my complaint is bitter; his hand is heavy in spite of my groaning. ³If only I knew where to find him; if only I could go to his dwelling! ⁴ I would state my case before him and fill my mouth with arguments. ⁵ I would find out what he would answer me, and consider what he would say to me.⁶ Would he vigorously oppose me? No, he would not press charges against me. ⁷ There the upright can establish their innocence before him, and there I would be delivered forever from my judge.⁸ "But if I go to the east, he is not there; if I go to the west, I do not find him. ⁹ When he is at work in the north, I do not see him; when he turns to the south, I catch no glimpse of him. ¹⁰ But he knows the way that I take; when he has tested me, I will come forth as gold. ¹¹ My feet have closely followed his steps; I have kept to his way without turning aside.¹² I have not departed from the commands of his lips; I have treasured the words of his mouth more than my daily bread.
